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Committee on Prescriptive Governance

The Committee on Prescriptive Governance (CPG) develops recommendations regarding the authority to prescribe drugs and therapeutic devices by advanced practice nurses who hold a certificate to prescribe issued by the Board.

Members, appointment of members, terms, and charge/purpose are set forth in Sections 4723.49, 4723.491, and 4723.492 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). Members include a clinical nurse specialist; a certified nurse-midwife; a certified nurse practitioner; a member of the Board of Nursing who is, at a minimum, a registered nurse; four physicians who meet the qualifications for appointment as specified in the ORC; a pharmacist member of the State Board of Pharmacy; and a pharmacist actively engaged in practice in Ohio as a clinical pharmacist.

The Board appoints members to CPG at various times of the year as members' terms end. The application is posted on the Board's web site as positions become open. If you are interested, please refer to the CPG roster that provides the positions and terms and watch for the application on the Board web site several months prior to the ending term.
