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Certified Nurse-Midwife (CNM) Applications for the Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing

The position for a CNM actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting is vacant.
The Board is seeking applications to fill this vacancy.

HB 216, effective April 6, 2017, established an Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing (APRN Advisory Committee). Section 4723.493, Ohio Revised Code. The APRN Advisory Committee is to advise the Board on the practice and regulation of APRNs and may also make recommendations to the Committee on Prescriptive Governance.

APRN Advisory Committee and Members

Recommendations for the CNM initial appointment may be submitted to the Board from organizations representing APRNs practicing in Ohio and from schools of advanced practice registered nursing. The initial term for this position is one year.

Committee members serve without compensation, but may receive payment for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.

There are no provisions about the number of Committee meetings to be held each year, but other Board advisory groups generally meet two to three times a year. Subsequent meeting dates will be determined and published following the June 12, 2017 initial meeting.

Members: a CRNA actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting; CNM actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting; an APRN actively engaged in providing primary care in Ohio and practicing in a clinical setting; an APRN actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting; two APRNs who each serve as a faculty member of an approved program of nursing education that prepares students for licensure as APRNs; a representative of an entity that employs ten or more APRNs actively engaged in practice in Ohio; a member of the Board who is an APRN.

CNMs Applying for the APRN Advisory Committee

The application to apply for the CNM position is posted on the Board website at www.nursing.ohio.gov.

Interested CNMs are to submit a completed application no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, July 3, 2017**.

Applicants should include a recommendation on the letterhead of either an organization representing APRNs practicing in this state or from a school of advanced practice registered nursing. Applicants should also include a resume or curriculum vitae.
