



## **Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing Summary Information – Applications and Appointments 2018**

Section 4723.493, Ohio Revised Code, establishes the Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing (APRN Advisory Committee). The APRN Advisory Committee advises the Board on the practice and regulation of APRNs and may also make recommendations to the Committee on Prescriptive Governance.

The Board will appoint three APRN Advisory Committee members in 2018: an APRN in primary care practice; a Certified Nurse-Midwife; and an APRN who is faculty in an APRN education program. The Board is posting the application for these positions. The appointments are for two-year terms.

### **The APRN Advisory Committee and Members**

- One CRNA actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting (filled)
- One CNM actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting (**to be appointed**)
- One APRN actively engaged in providing primary care in Ohio and practicing in a clinical setting (**to be appointed**)
- One APRN actively engaged in practice in Ohio in a clinical setting (filled)
- Two APRNs who each serve as a faculty member of an approved program of nursing education that prepares students for licensure as APRNs (**one position to be appointed**)
- One representative of an entity that employs ten or more APRNs actively engaged in practice in Ohio (filled)
- A member of the Board who is an APRN

Recommendations for the APRN appointments may be submitted to the Board from organizations representing APRNs practicing in Ohio and from schools of advanced practice registered nursing for APRN Faculty applicants.

Committee members serve without compensation, but members may receive payment for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.

### **Applying for the APRN Advisory Committee**

The application to apply for the APRN Advisory Committee is posted on the Board website at [www.nursing.ohio.gov](http://www.nursing.ohio.gov).

Interested individuals are to submit a completed application no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 4, 2018.

Applicants should include a recommendation on the letterhead of either an organization representing APRNs practicing in this state or from a school of advanced practice registered nursing for APRN Faculty applicants. Applicants should also include a resume or curriculum vitae.

In the subject line specify, "Application for APRN Advisory Committee." The Board will notify applicants of appointments no later than May 25, 2018.

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The APRN Advisory Committee will meet on May 14, 2018; June 11, 2018; and October 1, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., at the Board office in Columbus. There are no provisions about the number of Committee meetings to be held each year, but other Board advisory groups generally meet two to three times a year.
