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Committee on Prescriptive Governance (CPG) May 21, 2019, 10:00 a.m.

Call to Order

Sherri Sievers, Chair, recognized a quorum, called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m. and welcomed members and guests.

Review and Approval November 2018 Meeting Minutes

Richard Bakker moved to approve the minutes as written; Katherine Clark seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Review New Approved FDA Drugs and Exclusionary Formulary

After reviewing new drugs approved by the FDA from December 26, 2019, through April 26, 2019, Barbara Douglas moved to not add any of the drugs to the Exclusionary Formulary; R. Bakker seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Exclusionary Formulary: Review Technical Change

The CPG reviewed the technical changes to the Exclusionary Formulary. K. Clark moved to approve the changes; B. Douglas seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Nursing Board Memorandum 2019 Five Year Rule Review

Lisa Emrich stated Board Staff is recommending the revision of Rule 4723-9-10, OAC, to include the Exclusionary Formulary in rule for prescribing based on input from JCARR. Rule 4723-9-13, OAC, will be changed to include Certified Nurse Midwives as prescribers of medication-assisted treatment consistent with updated federal law. An Interested Party Meeting will be held on June 17, 2019, at 1:00pm. This is the same day as the Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing meeting, so members may also attend the Interested Party Meeting.

Other

CPG members noted there were no applications submitted for the APRN position and asked whether it was necessary to continue to convene the CPG. Tom Dilling stated the CPG was authorized in HB 216, and another statutory change would be needed for it to be discontinued. If APRNs would like to discontinue the CPG, he stated there may be an opportunity to add a provision to HB 177, which currently includes the removal of the mandatory Standard Care Arrangement; CPG members may want to contact their associations. He said another option is the Sunset Review Committee. Within the next three years the Board of Nursing will be reviewed and can make a statement regarding the CPG.
