## Online Resources for Ohio Law Governing Drugs and Prescriptive Authority CNP, CNS, and CNMs

If you are currently licensed as a CNP, CNS, or CNM in another state and you are applying for reciprocity to be licensed in Ohio, you must complete a minimum of two contact hours of continuing education (CE) covering Ohio law governing drugs and prescriptive authority.

If this is your first CNP, CNS, or CNM license after completing an APRN education program **that is not located in Ohio**, you must complete the two hours of CE on Ohio law governing drugs and prescriptive authority if it was not included in the advanced pharmacology course you completed as part of your APRN education program.
