



## **Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing Summary Information – Applications and Appointments 2021**

Section 4723.493, Ohio Revised Code, establishes the Advisory Committee on Advanced Practice Registered Nursing (APRN Advisory Committee) to advise the Board on the practice and regulation of APRNs.

The Board will appoint APRN Advisory Committee members at the May 18-19, 2021 Board meeting for the four open positions. Recommendations for appointments may be submitted to the Board from organizations representing APRNs practicing in Ohio and from schools of advanced practice registered nursing for APRN faculty applicants.

### **Open Positions (Two-Year Terms)**

All of the following appointments will be effective May 21, 2021:

- One APRN actively engaged in practice in Ohio and practicing in a clinical setting.
- One CRNA actively engaged in practice in Ohio and practicing in a clinical setting.
- One APRN who serves as a faculty member of an approved program of nursing education that prepares students for licensure as APRNs.
- One representative of an entity that employs ten or more APRNs actively engaged in practice in Ohio. The law does not specify that this representative must be an APRN.

### **Applying for the APRN Advisory Committee**

The application to apply for the APRN Advisory Committee is posted on the Board website at [www.nursing.ohio.gov](http://www.nursing.ohio.gov).

Interested individuals are to submit an application no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 3, 2021.

Applicants should include a recommendation on the letterhead of either an organization representing APRNs practicing in this state or from a school of advanced practice registered nursing for APRN Faculty applicants. Applicants should also include a resume or curriculum vitae.

## **Meetings**

This Advisory Committee generally meets 3-4 times a year. Currently the meetings are held virtually using Microsoft Teams but may be convened in person at the Board office in Columbus if conditions allow.

The remaining meetings for 2021 are on July 12 and November 9 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Committee members serve without compensation, but members may receive payment for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.
